#### **A Brief Profile**

Govt. College Jawalaji initially came into being on 1st July 1999 as erstwhile privately managed institution known as 'Jawalaji Degree College', Jawalamukhi run under the auspices of 'Jawalaji' Shiksha Samiti and taken over by Government of Himachal Pradesh, Department of Higher Education on 8th June 2016. Up to 11-03 2024, it was named as Govt. College Jawalaji and then on 12 March 2024 it was renamed as Freedom Fighter Pandit Susheel Rattan Government Degree College Jawalamukhi. This institution duly granted 2(f) status by UGC, is a pioneer of higher education in this area of District Kangra and Jawalamukhi Assembly Constituency, in particular. This institution is affiliated with HPU Shimla (BA/BSC/BCOM/BBA/BCA 1st and 3rd year ) and SPU Mandi (BA/BSC/BCOM/BBA/BCA 2ndyear). The staff and students are making concerted efforts to make it an institute par excellence. The college is ever devoted to broadening its horizon of education and adding new courses. College has been declared as Institute of Excellence by Govt. of Himachal Pradesh Department of Education vide letter no. EDUC-B015/11/2023-EDU-C-Part-I dt. 14th March 2024.

The college is located in the pristine surroundings with the mighty Dhauladhar ranges in the background and in the blessings of 'Maa Jawalaji' across NH-303 at a distance of about 2 KM from the historical town of Jawalamukhi, district Kangra (H.P.). The college provides facilities for indoor games and has a gymnasium with equipment for exercise and fitness training. The college has well equipped laboratories for all science and arts subjects. 1. Candidate must save the "User name and Password" generated during registration process with

- 1. Admission will be made on the recommendation of admission committee.

#### 2.3 AGE LIMIT

A student who has attained the age of 23 years for boys & 25 years for girls on 1<sup>st</sup>July, 2024 (Upper age limit is raised to 26 years for ST/SC candidates). The Vice-Chancellor shall have the power to permit age relaxation up to a maximum period of 6 months.

#### 2.4 BASIS OF ADMISSION

#### 2.4.1 Subsidized Seats:

Admission shall be made on the basis of merit list determined on the basis of marks obtained in Matriculation and +2 examinations. A candidate with Commerce or Mathematics at +2 levels will be given additional 10% of the percentage marks obtained in +2, while computing merit for Admission .75% of seats shall be reserved for those who have passed their qualifying

examinations from H.P. Board of School Education/H.P. University.

#### 2.4.2 Non-Subsidized Seats:

Non-Subsidized Seats will be filled on the basis of First Come First Served.

This applies only to NRIs Payment Categories. In case of NRIs, this scheme admits students as per the merit in the past examinations passed by the candidate. Top 10 NRIs candidates shall be admitted to this programme.

#### **Proof of status in the case of NRI**

For this purpose, either of the following documents shall be considered as a proper proof:

Copy of the Non-resident card/Employment card issued by the employers.

Photocopy of the immigration card/employment VISA entry on the passport along with details of passport.

Certificate issued by Indian Embassy/high commission in the country where NRI residing.

Photocopy of the latest assessment order of income Tax Authorities either in India or the country of Employment filled in the status of NRI.

In case of non-availability of NRIs, the seats under non-subsidized category will be filled on First Come First Served.

#### 2.4.3 To Resolve A Tie:

In case of tie, the candidate having higher aggregate marks in the qualifying examination shall be admitted first.

If the tie is still not resolved the candidate younger in age will be admitted first.

#### 2.4.4 RESERVATION OF SEATS

ReservationRoster200-Pointasapprovedbythe State Government will be applicable.

Totalmanagementseatswillbe10% of theseatsfor Himachali Bonafidecandidatesi.e. 10% of 42 seats in case of 50 seats and 10% of 85 seats in case of 100 seats allotted to the Colleges as per Orders of the

Hon'ble High Court of H.P. vide CWP No.4500 of 2009 dated July 29, 2010. The management seats will be filled up by the management of Institute on the basis of merit of the Entrance Test through its own counseling in a transparent manner. #### **DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE**

#### **BACHELOR OF COMPUTER APPLICATION (BCA)**

#### Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA) scheme of examinations:-

- a) The Duration of BCA shall be three years split over six semesters.
- b) There shall be an examination at the end of each semester in the month of April and October on the dates to be notified by the Controller of Examinations.
- c). The courses of study and syllabi shall be as pre-scribed by the Board of Studies/Faculty from time to time. Other rules will be similar to those for the corresponding examinations in the University.
- d). Pass percentage of marks: The pass marks in each paper shall be 40%.
- e). A candidate should have passed at least 50% marks of 1st year i.e. 1st and 2nd semester to get admission to 3rd semester of 2nd year and pass in 50% papers of 1st and 2nd year shall determine the eligibility for admission to 5th semester of 3rd year.
- f). A candidate obtaining pass marks in any course shall not be required to re-appear in that course again however the candidate shall be required to complete his BCA Degree within at a maximum of five years.
- g). The successful candidates shall be classified in three divisions as under:
  - i) First Division: Those who obtains 60% or more of the aggregate marks.
  - ii) Second Division: Those who obtain 50% or more but less than 60% of the aggregate marks.
  - iii) Third Division: Those who obtain less than 50% of the aggregate marks.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Candidates who have passed 10+2 examination from H.P. Board/CBSE/ICSE or any other examination considered equivalent to 10+2, by the Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla-5 with 40% Marks(35% marks for SC/ST category) shall be eligible.

Maximum age limit for admission to BCA course is 21 years for general category and 24 years for SC/ST category and 23 years for girls candidates as on the 1st July of the year concerned. The Vice Chancellor may permit age relaxation up to maximum of three months.

#### BASIS OF ADMISSION

#### Mode of Selection

The admission to BCA course will be made on the basis of merit of the qualification. As per HPUniversity rules 75% seats will be filled out of the candidates who have passed their 10+2 examination from the school situated in HPirrespective of the Board. Remaining 25% seats will be filled on all India basis. Other reservation rules of HPU shall be applicable. BCA is three years Degree course based on Semester of Examination.

#### ELIGIBILITY FOR PROMOTION

A candidates should have passed at least 50% papers of 1st year i.e. 1st and 2nd Semester to get admission to 3rd Semester of 2nd year and pass in 50% papers of 1st and 2nd year shall determine the eligibility for admission to 5th Semester of 3rd year.

The pass marks in each subject shall be 40% while appearing in the examination within two available chances.

The successful candidates shall be classified in three divisions as under

- (i) First Division: 60% or more of the aggregate marks.
- (ii) Second Division: 50% or more but less than 60% of the aggregate marks.
- (iii) Third Division: Less than 50% of the aggregate marks.

The candidate shall be required to complete his/her BCA degree within a maximum period of five years.

#### HOUSE EXAMINATION & LECTURE ATTENDANCE

Every student has to appear in the House Examination and secure at least 20% marks in each subject or 25% marks in aggregate. Every student must attend 75% lectures both in theory or practical separately.

Examination Fee will be charged as per University rules.

#### RESERVATION OF SEATS FOR BBA & BCA

Admission to the courses shall be subject to the following conditions:

- a) 15% and 7.5 % seats shall be reserved for SC and ST candidates respectively, who have passed their qualifying examination from H.P. Board of School Education or any other school located within the Tarriotrial jurisdiction of H.P. Or any other school board e.g. CBSE or ICSE etc.
- b) The remaining seats shall be filled as under:
  - 25% of the remaining seats for admission shall be open for all the candidates irrespective of the institution from where they have passed their qualifying examination.

- ii) 75% of the remaining seats shall be filled out of the candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from H.P. Board of School Education or any ather school located within the territorial jurisdiction of H.P. Or any other school boards e.g. CBSE or ICSE etc.
- c) 5% of the seats shall be reserved for outstanding sportsmen/women.

#### Sports seats shall be filled according to following rules:

- Sportsmen/Women seeking admission to BBA Department of the University in a Post-Graduate Degree
  Course/Diploma Course should be eligible to play in the Inter-University/Inter-University Championship
  as per rules and regulations for Inter-College Tournaments.
- Admission against outstanding sports quota would be made once in the begining of the academic session.
   No forms for such admission would be entertained after the expiry of the last date of the submission of forms for admission in the University.
- Only those Sportsmen/Women would be considered for admission against outstanding sports quota, who
  have represented the University or State in the Inter University or Inter-State Championship Tournaments
  respectively.
- The Sportsmen/Women seeking admission against outstanding sports quota should also qualify the Minimum eligibility conditions for admission in that course as provided under the rules.
- 5. In order to judge the suitability of players for admission in sports quota, trials would be held in the respective games/sports, by a Committee to be constituted by the Director of Physical Education and Youth Programmes, who will be the Chairman of the Committee and recommendation of the Committee would be kept in view while giving admission. The original certificates would also be seen by the Committee at the time of trials. In case, a certificate is issued on Association pad, it should be duly signed and stamped by both the President and the Secretary of the respective Association.
- The admission against sports quota would be given to such candidates who have represented the University
   State in the Inter-University/Inter State Competition in the following games.

#### Men's Section

Hockey, Football, Vollyball, Basketball, Kabaddi, Wrestling, Boxing, Table Tennis, Badminton, Cross Country, Cricket, Atletics, Weight Lifting, Handball, Chess, Kho-Kho, Judo Taikwondo and other games included in the list of Inter College Tournaments by the Sports & Co-curricularneil of H.P. University from time to time.

#### Women's Section

Hockey, Athletics, Basketball, Volleyball, Table Tennis, Badminton, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Hand Ball, Weight Lifting, Boxing, Cross-Country, Judo, Chess, Taikwondo and other games included in the list of Inter College Tournaments by the Sports & Co-curricularneil of H.P. University from time to time.

- For students who are given admission on sports basis, it will be compulsory to attend the sports activities (in his/her sports) regularly.
- A) Any student who without adequate reasons is found to be avoiding his/her games/sports activities will be liable for disciplinary action, leading to the cancellation of his/her admission.
  - B) 5% of the seats shall be reserved for outstanding cultural activists.

#### Cultural seats shall be filled according to the following rules

- Admission against outstanding cultural quota at par with sports quota would be made once, in the beginning
  of the academic session. No forms for such admission would be entertained after the expiry of the last date of
  the submission of forms for admission in the University.
- 2. Candidates who are employed are not eligible for admission against cultural quota in any of the courses.
- Only those students will be eligible for admission against outstanding cultural quota who are having at least
   I, II, III in Inter-School Cultural Competition in any of the previous three years.
- 4. While considering admissions against cultural quota only the following Cultural items will be considered Debate, Indian Folk Dance, Indian Classical Music (Vocal), Indian Classical Music (Instrumental) Light Vocal Music, Vadya Vadan, Group Singing, Indian Classical Dance, One Act Play/Short Play/Skit Symposium, Poetic Symposium, Spot Painting, Quizzing, Western Group Song, Western Solo, Rangoli, Clay Modelling, Elocution, Poetic Recitation, Cartooning, Collage, Poster Making, Photography, Folk Dance, Orchestra and Mimicry.

**Note:** The distinction in the individual item will be given preference over the Team Items. The students seeking admission against outstanding cultural quota should also qualify the minimum eligibility condition for admission in that course provided under rules.

- For students who are given admission on cultural quota basis it will be compulsory to represent the Himachal Pradesh University in cultural activities.
- Any student who without adequate reason is found to be avoiding his/her cultural activity, will be liable ff action leading to the cancellation of his/her admission.
- 7. In order to judge the suitability of the candidates for admission against cultural quota, trials would be held in the respective cultural items by a Committee comprising coordinators and two persons to be nominated by the Principal and recommendations of the committee will be final. Original certificates would be seen by the Committee at the time of trials.
- 8. As per the Hon'ble High Court in case no. 642 of 2006, Abhishek V/s Himachal Pradesh the admission under Cultural quota will be made on the basis of marks obtained in Entrance Test/qualifying examination. The trials

would be held to judge the suitability of the candidates only. For the selection under cultural quota, those candidates are entitled to be admitted in the course, who possess higher merit in the entrance test/qualifying examination than others.

C) 3% of the seats shall be reserved for physical challenged candidates.

**Note:** If no suitable cultural and sports candidate is available then the seats will be offered to General Category. If no suitable sportsman, cultural candidate and physical challenged candidates is available than the seat/seats

#### LIBRARY RULE:

Every students will be issued an Identity Card. Since "I-Card" is the only medium to identity/differentiate a bonafide college student from and outsider, every student must always carry it with him/her and must produce it whenever required (during all working days, examination(s) and college functions(s) etc.) Otherwise he/she will be considered as outsider and will be punished accordingly.

If the I-Card is lost, a duplicate card will be issued only after an FIR is registered with the nearest police station and an original copy thereof is appended with such a request. Rs. 20/- are to be deposited for a duplicate Identity Card.

- iii) A student is liable to pay all dues and fines as long as his/her name remains on the college rolls.
- iv) The Principal reserves the right of expulsion/suspension of any student if the situation warrants so.

#### 2. LEAVE RULES

- i) Application for any kind of leave on the prescribed Performa should be submitted well in time.
- ii) Leave up to three days will be sanctioned by the concerned subject teacher.
- iii) The Head of Department is competent to sanction.
- v) In case of medical leave for a period of six days or more the applicant must produce a medical certificate.

#### **IMPORTANT:**

Students participating on inter-college competitions should note that the practice/rehearsal timing should be either before the classes (early morning) or after the classes (evening) because all such activities do not substitute academics/studies.

### **Library Rule:**

Every student will be issued an Identity Card. Since "I-Card" is the only medium to identify/differentiate a bonafide college student from an outsider, every student must always carry it with him/her and must produce it whenever required (during all working days, examination(s) and college function(s) etc.). Otherwise he / she will be considered as outsider and will be punished accordingly.

If the I-Card is lost, a duplicate and will be issued only after an FIR is registered with the nearest police station and as original copy thereof is appended with such a request.

Rs. 20/- are to be deposited for a duplicate Identity Card.
